

Livestock Skills Test & Record Books

The exhibitors will have to turn in their fully **completed** record books and take a **mandatory** skills test in each livestock department that they are registered. Each skills test will be divided into three divisions: junior, intermediate and senior. The department superintendents will grade the record books and put a letter grade on the front of each book. I will then get the books back and check off all the names of exhibitors who took the skills test and put the final grades in the computer. If they did not take the test their grade will automatically go down one letter grade. The lower the letter grade, the lower the premium. Please share this with all exhibitors that are planning on attending the Attica Fair.

Record Book Turn In & Skills Test:

Exhibitors will have two (2) days to turn in their record books. When turning in the record book they will also have to take the skills test.

Saturday, August 4th, 2018

Sunday, August 5th, 2018

12:00 – 3:00 PM

Grading:

There will be three (3) letter grades that the exhibitors can receive depending on their effort.

“A” – Book is completed fully & skills test taken.

“B” – Book is partially completed & skills test taken.

“C” – Book not turned in or not completed and/or test not taken and could result in not being able to compete for grand or reserve champion or sell at livestock sale.

Skills Test:

There will be seven (7) different tests available to take: steer, feeder, hog, goat, sheep, poultry and rabbits.

Beginner Test: ages 8-11

Intermediate Test: ages 12-14

Senior Test: ages 15 & up

(All ages are as of January 1st of the current year.)
