The Attica Independent Agricultural Society, Ohio State University Extension, FFA, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts and all involved in the Attica Fair support a code of good sportsmanship in all events and promote learning and responsibility through its activities. Verbal abuse, physical abuse or harassment toward directors, judges, ring stewards, superintendents, OSU Extension staff, Jr. Fair members, club advisors or volunteers of the Attica Fair will not be tolerated. Offenders may be escorted from the fairgrounds; premiums forfeited, and upon the Attica Fair Board of Director's decision, the family members may not be able to exhibit at the Attica Fair for a period of time indicated by the committee based on the severity of the situation.

#### Code of Conduct

All exhibitors, parents, and public must abide by the rules of the Attica Junior and Senior Fairs or will be asked to leave the grounds, forfeit any premiums and awards, and will be subject to further sanctions appropriate to the offending actions. No exhibitor, their immediate family, or any other party involved in unethical practices shall be permitted to exhibit at the Attica Fair, having been banned for disciplinary or ethical reasons from other county, independent, or state fairs for a period commensurate with the ban.
