## <u>Seneca County Bred, Born and Raised Market Goat Show</u> <u>Attica Fair</u>

An exhibitor may show one (1) of their market goats in the County Market goat class IF it was bred, born and raised in Seneca County and born on or after January 1<sup>st</sup> and before April 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year. Entries must be made at the same time as Attica Fair entry forms (June 15th).

If the exhibitor wins Grand or Reserve Champion during the Jr. Fair goat show, that goat will not be able to participate in this contest. Another goat can be shown by said exhibitor as long as it meets the qualifications as listed.

<u>Market Dairy Goats</u> – Must conform to the breed standards and be 100% Dairy or a combination of the following: Alpine, LaMancha, Nubian, Saanen, Toggenburg, Dairy/Dairy Cross, Nigerian Dwarf, Sable.

<u>Market Boer/Boer-Cross Goats</u> – Must conform to the breed standards and be 100% Market Meat or a combination of the following: Boer, Kiko, Spanish, Tennessee, Meat/Meat Cross, Dairy/Meat Cross.
